A LEVEL THEOLOGY, PHILOSOPHY & ETHICS

- Cover relevant issues in modern society through theological, philosophical and ethical lenses
- Develop key skills, such as creativity, problem solving, analytical skills and persuasive writing.



YOU WILL STUDY

Philosophy of Religion:

This part of the course focuses on the study of Ancient Greek philosophers, Plato and Aristotle, arguments for the existence of God, challenges to religious belief, and claims to religious experience.

Ethics:

Focuses on questions relating to moral decision-making, the nature of ethical language, and applied issues including euthanasia and business ethics.

Christianity:

Covers issues such as the existence of God, death and afterlife, gender and theology, and the challenge of secularism.
