

Carmel College Provider Access Policy

This Policy sets out the College's arrangements for managing the access to College of Universities, Employers and other Colleges for the purpose of providing information about their offer. This complies with the Colleges' legal obligation under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Student Entitlement

All students in years 12 and 13 are entitled:

To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeship opportunities as part of a programme that provides information on a full range of education and training options at transition points.

To hear from a range of providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships, through careers events, tutor groups and within subject areas.

To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

For Students in Year 12 and 13, particularly those who have not decided on their next steps, students must have at least two provider encounters during this two year period , which are optional for pupils to attend.

These provider encounters will occur during the main college hours and the provider will be given a reasonable amount of time to share information, and to explain what career routes those careers options could lead to.

Meaningful provider encounters

One encounter is defined as one meeting/session between students and one provider.

Meaningful online engagement is also an option, and we are open to providers that are able to provide live online engagement with our students.
